WHEREAS, the "Roarin' Blue Band" was the only band from Region 9 to advance to the State Marching Band Competition on November 5, 2013 at the Alamo Dome in San Antonio, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the "Roarin' Blue Band" ultimately placed 17 out of 28 among the high school bands competing in the Class 4A UIL State Band Competition; and

WHEREAS, by placing 17th, the "Roarin' Blue Band" is among the top 1 percent in the state of Texas; and

whereas, the City of Tomball and the Tomball Independent School District wish to congratulate the more than 200 band members and approximate 25 colorguard members of the "Roarin' Blue Band", along with Head Director Andy Easton, Assistant Directors Chris King and Dusty Brown, Colorguard Instructor Tim LeBlanc, the Band parents and supporters, and countless others who have worked together to make this the best-ever high school band in Tomball;
